Total families 36, all under zarooratmund category. jamaat is not helping them for Shehre Ramadan observances. <p style="text-align: center;">MIRA ROAD</p> <p>Fully developed Township between Bhayandar-E and Dahisar, Buildings are nicely constructed with pucca structure but without proper water facility. Nearly 400 families of mumineen living permanently here and registered them with Mira Road jamaat. However there are atleast 150 more families registered elsewhere but living here and changing their accommodation time to time every 11 months on Leave and Licence basis. jamaat have an open ground with Kachcha shed as Markaz where 100 children are attending Madrasa. The place is unfit for Shehrullal namaz as it can accommodate hardly 55 thal. The Markaz is not situated on any road touch location. One has to walk sizable ups and down to reach markaz from the nearest road level. Zahra Hasanaat has done a borwell. Markaz needs much cleanliness, better drinking water facilities and vaccum cleaner. No. of families: 195 living with better living standard.</p> <p><u>Kurar Village:</u> No. of families : 22 Situated at Malad East and also on the Eastern side of the Highway.</p> <p>Mumineen have to pass through congested market (bazar) and cross the highway to reach the markaz situated at a distance of 1 km. away. Dawat is also constructing (nearly on completion) a building in Vasind – East to occupy another 13 families. Kabrastan is also allotted by State Govt. jamaat need funds to build Gusalkhana in Kabrastan. At present 22 families reside here. There is no moallim. Notes:

1. Much improvement is necessary on the quality of Jaman.
2. Method of serving requires involvement of trained persons. Safra, Taraktee, Pure Water, Napkins, Bichona, all needs regular Safai. Zahra Hasanaat members on their visits concentrates on these issues but still much is required to be done. To secure co-operation of jamaat authorities is found difficult in many centres.
3. Those houses which are not having water connections are provided with Mineral water on all 30 days. Many of them were provided with domestic water filters during past years. During Shere Ramadan we have provided free candles and water purification drops to nearly 60 families.
4. Zahra Hasanaat has achieved good rapport with our people due to number of Medical Camps conducted during the last year.
5. Zahra Hasanaat Mobile Medical Van equipped with a Physician and with variety of medicine was inaugurated this year on the Urs Mubarak of Syedna Taher Saifuddin Saheb A.Q. by Mazoonmola T.U.S. The van has been moving in all suburban centres at regular intervals to develop awareness about keeping good health and eating healthy foods, particularly of nutritional values.
